Saturday, March 11, 2017

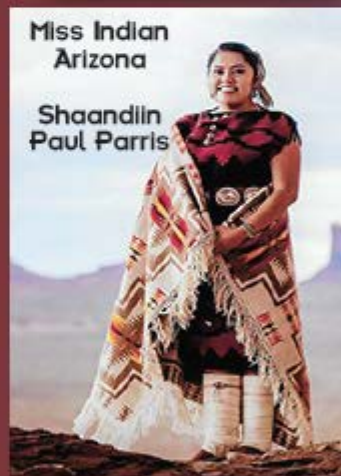
9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
